Responsibilities

- Conduct initial exam of animal including taking vital signs, drawing blood, collecting specimens, and gathering medical histories.
- Calm and soothe patients; safely restrain, transport, and handle patients; and prepare patients for treatments and procedures.
- Provide emergency first aid; monitor critical patients; participate in and assist with procedures and treatments; administer medication as prescribed by a veterinarian.
- Prepare equipment for surgical procedures; clean and organize treatment and examination rooms.
- Educate clients and owners on treatment plans, behavior changes, feeding, exercise and overall wellness for their animals; update patient medical records.
- Participate in teaching veterinary students and assist with research activities.
- Other duties as assigned. Duties will vary across service lines.

Minimum Qualifications

Graduation from an AVMA accredited Veterinary Technology Program.

Licensure as a Registered Veterinary Technician in the State of Missouri, or eligibility to obtain Missouri Licensure within 6 months after start date.

- Continuous learning and professional growth and development mindset.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills and the ability to interact effectively with diverse internal and external stakeholders, constituents, and clients.
