Standard responsibilities will vary based on clinic needs, but may include:

- Safely restrain, handle and transport patients
- Exercise patients in designated area as instructed
- Clean, organize and stock treatment and examination rooms
- Respond to phone inquiries regarding appointments
- Utilize hospital information system and other software for data entry
- Assist with monitoring hospitalized patients and provide ward care
- Collect samples (e.g., blood, urine and fecal) and administer medications as instructed
- Perform basic diagnostic procedures as requested within skill set of the particular assistant consistent with MVMB guidelines.
- Prepare operating room set-up / break-down and cleaning instruments and surgical suite
- Maintain and care for diagnostic and surgical equipment.

The Veterinary Health Center Small Animal Emergency is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Positions are part-time, working 20 hours a week on one of the following schedules:

- Position 1 - Thursday and Friday 10p - 8a
- Position 2 - Friday and Saturday 10p - 8a
- Position 3 - Saturday and Sunday 10p - 8a

Schedules are subject to change based on clinic needs and will be discussed during interview

Minimum Qualifications:

High school diploma or equivalent experience from which comparable knowledge and skills can be acquired is necessary.

The preferred applicant should:

- Enjoy working in a fast-paced collaborative environment with limitless learning opportunities.
- Possess excellent communication skills in order to interact with pet families and the veterinary team.
- Be detailed-oriented and well organized to gather medical histories, carry out instructions, document patient statistics, and update computerized medical records to ensure appropriate billing.
- Enjoy working with animals and have the ability to comfort, handle and restrain large and/or small patients.
