

## Suggested syllabus statements for external study sites

Please feel free to choose from one of these statements or craft your own regarding the use of your teaching materials on external study sites. These sites can be valuable learning tools but it is recommended that you stress in class the importance of safe guarding material on external sites so that copyright laws are not violated.

You might also consider placing watermarks across any valuable images or material in the case of inadvertent distribution by students or others. You must redact all client/patient information from images.
