Minimum Qualifications:

Applicants should have a D.V.M., Ph.D., or equivalent degree in a relevant field, and should be able to provide evidence of exceptional teaching ability.

Candidate will be evaluated on:

- Candidates seeking a tenure track position at the Assistant Professor level should demonstrate potential of establishing a nationally recognized research program and obtaining extramural funding.
- Candidates seeking an Associate Professor level position, either tenure-track or with tenure, should have an established, extramurally funded, nationally recognized research program. A successful candidate is expected to possess the ability to work effectively with individuals and groups with a variety of identities, cultures, backgrounds, and ideologies.

Application Materials:

Applications should include: a cover letter stating career goals; a curriculum vitae; a teaching philosophy, including a concise summary of teaching experiences; and the names of three professional references.
